Ordinance No. 11-12-2013-05

ESTABLISHING A FEE TO RECOVER COSTS FOR FIRE/RESCUE CALLS


Whereas, The Town Board of the Town of Walworth deems it appropriate pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 60.55 and 60.557, as a Town with Village Powers, to establish a fee to recover costs for fire/rescue call responses.

(a) When the agency providing fire/rescue services under contract to the town is called to provide service to a property owner in the Town of Walworth, the costs of that service shall be charged to that property owner as provided in Wis. Stats. #60.55(2)(b).


(b.) The costs of fire/rescue calls as outlined in subsection (a) shall be billed by the Town Clerk/Treasurer to the property owner within 90 days and paid to the Town Clerk/Treasurer within 60 days of the date of the bill. The failure to pay the bill within 60 days will result in interest being charged at the rate of one and one-half (1 ½) percent per month from the date of the bill. Those bills remaining outstanding, including interest, for more than 60 days as of November 1 of any year, shall become a lien against the real estate from which fire/rescue service was provided and shall be placed on the next tax roll as a delinquent special charge pursuant to Wis. Stats. 66.60

Passed by majority and roll call vote of the Town of Walworth Town Board and signed this 12th day of November, 2013.


The town clerk/treasurer shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80 of Wisconsin Statutes.




